

Peer Review of Resuscitation Teams

The whole team and team working should be assessed as a whole. The framework for marking below allows you to put comments in for feedback as well as scoring for numerical values.

The peer review system is designed to be a formative process.

Nobody runs a perfect resus and therefore if you find yourself scoring the team as all 4's then you may well be doing it wrong.

You may wish to keep page 2 in your portfolio as evidence of personal audit, relationship with colleagues etc.
